5 Tips for Creating Great AI Prompts

Be clear and specific

Instead of saying "Write a poem," try something like "Write a haiku about a lonely robot in a futuristic city"

Provide Context

For example, "Pretend you are a science teacher explaining black holes to a 6th-grade student"

Use Examples

For instance, "Write a story about a lost dog similar to the style of Dr. Seuss in The Cat in the Hat"

Identify Your Goal

When you have a clear goal, it becomes easier to evaluate the success of your prompt

Experiment and Iterate

Refine your prompt based on the response and experiment with variations of the original prompt



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
